PROPHETSTOWN PUBLIC WORKS MONTHLY REPORT

To the Mayor, City Council and Residents of Prophetstown

Here are some of the tasks completed by the Public Works Dept. along with other contracted projects during the month of December 2018 and into January 2019.

Water distribution system- The guys installed a new water service to 909 Swanson Dr. They repaired a water main break at 401 Dale Ave. Second round of water surveys were handed out for the PWS inventory.

Streets and Alleys- The guys took down the Christmas lights off the buildings on Main St and the Christmas wreaths that were on the light poles. They did some cold patching around various streets. Sand was hauled in to the stock pile. Road rock (Ca6) was hauled in to the stock pile.

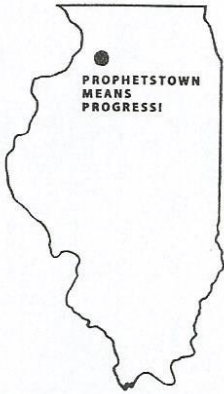
Sewer system- General/routine maintenance done.

E-Waste program- Waiting on pricing from URT. The program which was free for the city will now be charged for the removal of e-waste cause Whiteside County did not opt to be in the program for the 2019 season causing the towns that were in the program for the free service to have to pay for removal of e-waste for the 2019 season.

Equipment/Vehicles/Shop- The guys serviced all the plow trucks and heavy equipment.

Read water meters, pick up brush and landscape waste, along with the hauling of the landscape waste from the salt bin to our burn site(This is done on a weekly to bi-weekly basis) , Flush the old well on High street for monthly bacterial samples, we also take monthly bacterial water samples and fluoride samples form the water distribution system, waste water testing is done twice a month, take samples from the water tower for potable water testing (this is done on a daily basis),record running time numbers on all lift stations and water tower, (this is done 365 days a year) We also mow and maintain all of the city property.
